



## **CONTINUATION OF DISASTER DECLARATION**

**WHEREAS**, on April 23, 2020, the Mayor of the City of Hedwig Village, Texas, issued a disaster declaration declaring a state of disaster for the City of Hedwig Village, Texas, resulting from COVID-19 (novel coronavirus); and

**WHEREAS**, the conditions necessitating declaration of a state of disaster continue to exist; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 418.108(b) of the *Texas Government Code* provides that a local state of disaster may not be continued for a period in excess of seven days without the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hedwig Village City Council approved a continuation of the local disaster declaration for the City of Hedwig Village on April 30, 2020, until May 31, 2020, and approved a continuation on May 21, 2020, until June 28, 2020, and approved a continuation on June 18, 2020, until July 26, 2020 and again approved a continuation on July 16, 2020, until August 23, 2020;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HEDWIG VILLAGE, TEXAS THAT:**

1. The recitals set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated herein.
2. Pursuant to the authority provided in Section 418.108(b) of the *Texas Government Code*, the disaster declaration signed by Mayor Brian T. Muecke, dated April 23, 2020, and continued by the City Council on April 30, 2020, until May 31, 2020, and approved a continuation by the City Council on May 21, 2020, until June 28, 2020, and approved a continuation by the City Council on June 18, 2020, until July 26, 2020, and again approved a continuation by the City Council on July 16, 2020, until August 23, 2020, unless terminated by an earlier executive order of the Mayor, or terminated or modified by an earlier order of the City Council of the City.
3. This Continuation of Disaster Declaration is effective immediately.
