As we continue to battle the COVID-19 Pandemic, please know that the Hedwig Village Police Department is doing everything possible to protect our community. We are fully staffed and have increased patrols throughout the city. Please ensure you continue to lock your doors, set your alarms (even while you are home) and call us immediately if anything seems suspicious or out of place. Working together, we can keep Hedwig Village safe and secure.

In April 2020, we had the following criminal incidents in the Residential District of Hedwig Village:

Auto Theft

On April 20, 2020, a resident of the Memorial Green Apartments reported that his vehicle, a Chevrolet Pick-up, was stolen from the parking lot sometime between 7pm and 10:30pm.

Theft

On April 9, 2020, a resident on Moss Springs reported a girl's bicycle was stolen from the front yard sometime over the previous two days.

On April 30, 2020, a resident on Beinhorn Road reported that on April 27, 2020, he received an email purported to be from Charles Schwab asking him to call about his account. He phoned the number given and after providing his account information, the number disconnected. He later learned \$36,000 was stolen from his Charles Schwab account.
